

St. Augustine grass, is a coarse-textured, spreading grass that is popular throughout warmer regions of the Southern United States. It will turn brown with fall freezes and will be slow to green in the spring. It is the least cold tolerant of the warm-season turfgrasses.

Mowing Height: 2-3 inches.

Water Requirements: 1" / week

Fertilization: 2-4 lbs/Nitrogen/Year

Ideal Soil pH: 6-6.5
