



Tall Fescue, is a common lawn grass found worldwide. Classified as a cool season grass, Tall Fescue is typically active growing from mid-September through late June. In the hot and dry summer months, Tall Fescue transitions into its dormant state to protect itself from the heat and lack of moisture. Tall Fescue will transition from its dormant state when temperatures begin to cool down in the late summer.

Mowing Height: 3-4 inches.

Water Requirements: 1 - 1½" / week

Fertilization: 2-5 lbs/Nitrogen/Year

Ideal Soil pH: 5.5-6.5
